Who Should Attend?

The course is aimed at those who are currently working in or wish to consider moving to Research Quality Assurance. It is applicable to anyone who is involved in audit or inspection either within a formal quality system such as ISO 9001, GLP or GCP or in 'non-regulated' research and development.

What will be covered?

The course will cover the entire life-cycle of Research QA Audits and Inspections, including:

- Audit programmes and plans
- Planning the audit
- Conducting the audit:
 - The opening meeting
 - Gathering and analysing evidence
 - Asking questions and giving feedback
- Preparing the audit report
- Follow-up and improvement

The course is a mixture of presentations and workshops where the participants will get the opportunity to experience the audit life-cycle.

What Will You Get?

Training will be provided by Andrew Waddell, a recognised international expert in Research Quality Assurance. Participants will receive a full set of course notes and a certificate of training. Lunch and refreshments are included.

What is the Cost?
